THE PURPOSE OF MODIFICATION 006 IS TO ADVISE APPLICANTS OF THE DECISION TO SUSPEND THE SUBMISSION OF QUESTIONS AGAINST THIS FOA, PENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE TECHNICAL REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AGAINST ROUND 1. IF AFTER THE COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF ROUND 1 APPLICATIONS, IT IS DETERMINED THAT A ROUND 2 WILL BE CONDUCTED, THE IIPS PORTAL WILL BE REOPENED FOR THE SUBMISSION OF QUESTIONS. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE DECISION TO PROCEED OR NOT PROCEED TO ROUND 2, WILL BE MADE IN THE LATE AUGUST 2009 TIMEFRAME.
